District and State Meet are options for Dolphins swimmers age 7 and older, but there are certain conditions to attend these meets (including valid proof of age in the form of a birth certificate). The District Meet is a qualifying opportunity for State. A swimmer who attends this meet must be willing to commit to State if he or she qualifies for the team (a top 3 finish at District). In other words, swimmers who do not plan on going to State should not register for District. The date for the District Meet will be June 29th in Gainesville; State Meet will be July 20th (10 & Unders) and 21st (11 & Ups) in Cumming.
